Recipients: Albania, Bosnia & Hercegovina, Croatia, Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia

Size: 4,5 bn Euro 1991 – 1999 on part of EU

17 bn Euro including humanitarian assistance
+ contributions of member states

Definition:

- EU's main contribution to the stability pact
- Enhancement of the Regional Approach
- Stronger incentives for the region, but also an element of conditionality regarding political and economic development and regional cooperation
- Tailor-made approach taking into account the needs of each country



Goal: bring peace, stability, and economic development to the region and open the long-term perspective of EU membership
